## Call for papers

Abstracts of papers presenting student work on  
conservation of objects or related projects are  
invited.

Preference for oral presentation will be given to  
papers dealing with current research, which falls  
within the subjects, listed above.

Feel free to also send papers about ongoing  
projects where final results have not necessarily  
been obtained yet.

Presentations should be suitable for delivery in no  
more than 20 minutes.

The official language of the conference is English.  
All papers and sessions should be written and  
presented in English.

## Abstracts

Abstracts should include:

- the full title of the paper or session topic
- the full name of the student(s) related to  
the work, study semester and specialization
- full postal address and e-mail address
- summary of the paper or session topic in  
no more than 300 words.

It should include one representative picture of  
excellent quality (300 dpi, TIFF file) of the subject  
but no tables or references related to the subject.  
The organizers will allocate the accepted papers  
or session topics to the most appropriate theme  
session.

The deadline for submission of abstracts is 28th  
of February 2009. Authors will be notified of the  
result by 31st of March 2009.
