# Loss Compensation in Paintings: Filling and Retouching, with Laura Fuster-López

# 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> November 2011

**20|21 Conservação e Restauro,** a Portuguese contemporary art conservation studio, has invited Laura Fuster-López to teach a 3 day course aimed at paintings conservators.

Filling and retouching are increasingly a challenge for paintings conservators, considering the wide array of materials used in modern and contemporary works of art. Laura Fuster-López has been studying and teaching these subjects, and is willing to share with us the state of the art in this area.

# Overview

The aim of this Masterclass is to offer a panoramic view of the materials and techniques used for filling and retouching paintings, with a special focus in modern and contemporary paintings. **Topics will include:** 

| Mechanical and dimensional properties of filling materials

| Traditional, synthetic and commercial fillers

| Reproducibility and evaluation of filling formulations

| Materials and methods to reproduce textures and impasto

| Retouching materials and techniques, including recent innovations

Sessions will blend theory with practice, allowing participants to apply what they learn to the problems each one faces in their conservation practice. Participants are encouraged to bring their own case studies for group discussion.

Laura Fuster-López is an Associate Professor in the Department of Conservation and Restoration of Cultural Heritage at the Universidad Politécnica de Valencia. She graduated in Fine Arts (Conservation and Restoration of Cultural Heritage) in 1999 and received the Ph.D. degree in Conservation and Restoration of Cultural Heritage in 2006 from the Universidad Politécnica de Valencia (Valencia, Spain) with the thesis titled: 'Filling materials for canvas paintings: historic and technical evolution and physico-mechanical analysis'. She has published the book 'Fillers for canvas paintings: criteria, materials and methods' (UPV, 2004), as well as several chapters and papers on the study of the structural behavior of the formulations traditionally used for loss compensation in easel paintings. Her current research interests are focused on the study of the mechanical and dimensional properties of cultural materials as well as the effects of environment in their stability and preservation.
